I've recently been made more aware of the potential risks of uranium exploration and mining in Nova Scotia.

The means by which the provincial government has rushed the process of lifting the ban, issued the RFP and is anticipating contract award has all appearances of minimizing the degree of public awareness and avoiding public opposition. This form of action is a clear exhibit of the complete absence of respect for the democratic process, the constituents, the First Nations, protected areas, and the environment.

Uranium exploration and mining has been banned not only in British Columbia and Quebec, but also in New Zealand, Spain, Sweden, Virginia, and parts of Arizona, Ireland, and Australia. Significant environmental, health, and safety risks undeniably exist.
